I. The general notes and achievement

II. The activities are in progress in the present time

1. There are three classes for non-formal education community children from Monday to Friday
2. Weekend English Class for a half Saturday and Sunday
3. Full time English classes for intern from Monday to Friday
4. Sunday afternoon library class from 1:00 -3:30 pm
5. Sewing Center for 5 poor and jobless families which started in the first of March, 2016 and they started to get income since 4th of April, 2016 until now is in progress dramatically.
6. Supporting families: There are 6 families who are under support of our programs such as weekly rice supporting, medical care, milk, and counseling. There are two families who have HIV Aids, two families who have a lot of children and have no abilities, one drunken and violent families, and another one abandoned family.
7. We have rent the room for Thin Baby Family for two months since 9 of August till 9 of October, 2016 that costs 50 dollars for two months.

8. There was a group of three students from **National Institute of Social Affairs** started their tasks as interns from 13 June, 2016 up to 13 of September, 2016.
9. On 24 of August, 2016, we held the event with the students from National Institute of Social Affairs at Wat Chum pagoda and there were 50 students who participated in that event, 25 students were from Kork Roka primary school and other 25 were from SCCO.
10. We held the parent meeting on 4 of September, 2016 and there were 30 participants joined with us in the discussion.

III. Problem faced in the whole community

- ✓ Drug using is the main problem for the whole community.
- ✓ Gambling is also the core problem that does not only attract the children, teenagers, but also adults to play and spend a lot of money.
- ✓ Playing cards is now increasing dramatically and the authorities do not care.

IV. Future intention

- ✓ We are going to do some research to find out some students who dropped out of school from primary till high school in order to push them to school or let them join the vocational training at other organizations.
- ✓ We are going to have family meeting every two months regularly in order to counsel them to improve their children to get higher education and get successful with their families.
- ✓ We are going to do our best to find out any children who haven't attended to school and send them to school.
- ✓ We are building good relationship with other NGOs to find out the solutions and work closely with the state school teachers and local authorities.
